For Special District Candidates Only – Candidate Nomination Filing Process — Updated for 2026

The Tulare County Registrar of Voters Office has updated the nomination paperwork filing process for the 2026 General Election. **Candidates will no longer use the Nomination Portal to submit their nomination paperwork. All nomination filing is now completed in person at our office.**

How to File: One-Appointment Process

All candidates must schedule and complete one in-person appointment during the filing period. Appointments can be scheduled on our website or by calling our office.

Before Your Appointment — Download Forms

Visit our website to download and complete the following forms prior to your appointment: Candidate Application, Code of Fair Campaign Practices, Candidate Statement Form, and Ballot Designation Worksheet (Optional).

Appointment — Submit Your Application and Complete Your Filing

Bring your completed Candidate Application, Code of Fair Campaign Practices, Candidate Statement Form, and Ballot Designation Worksheet to your in-person appointment. Once your Candidate Application is approved, you will be issued your Declaration of Candidacy. If you choose to file a Candidate Statement of Qualifications, the payment is due at this time. Special District candidates must file a hard copy of their Form 700 directly with the Registrar of Voters office, and your candidate filing will be complete.
